### European Council Conclusions – 1 & 2 Oct 2020

*"The two mutually reinforcing pillars of [the Recovery Package], the **green transition** and the **digital transformation**, together with a strong and deep Single Market, will foster new forms of growth, promote cohesion and convergence, and strengthen the EU's resilience. Achieving strategic autonomy while preserving an open economy is a key objective of the Union."*







## International partnerships for the digital decade

- Reflecting our values and promoting our interests, including a commitment to multilateralism
- Open, rules based trade on a level playing field
- A toolbox supporting our four cardinal points to build strong international partnerships
  - regulatory cooperation
  - research & innovation
  - investments in connectivity, etc., including via the Team Europe approach
- The EU-time zones with Africa and the Neighbourhood and key global partners
- Building on our renewed transatlantic relationship towards coalition with like-minded partners
